

Cape Air has grown from a single aircraft and route in 1989 to America's largest commuter airline today

Cape Air has begun operation of its scheduled commuter airline service between the Provincetown Airport and Boston's Logan Airport.






Cape Air codeshares with American at Quincy

- Flights at connecting airports operate with the codeshare of jetBlue




St. Louis connecting itineraries are sold on AA's website as American flights due to Cape Air's codeshare relationship with American Airlines







Cape Air proposes a combination of both 24x weekly flights to St. Louis Lambert and 12x weekly to Chicago O'Hare


Midwest route map showing Chicago – Quincy




